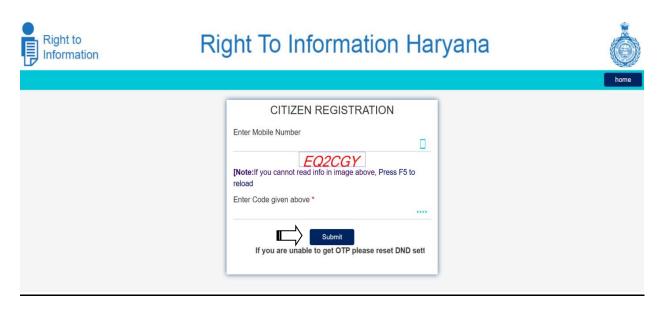


This is the main dashboard inside for citizen menu > Citizens Login

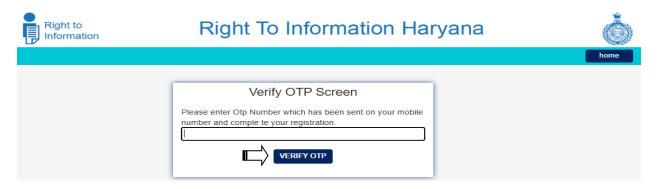
If you're a new user then kindly register yourself through New User Registration option.

Citizens can register for RTI account by filling this User Registration Form. Enter all the necessary details carefully as this is the one time process.

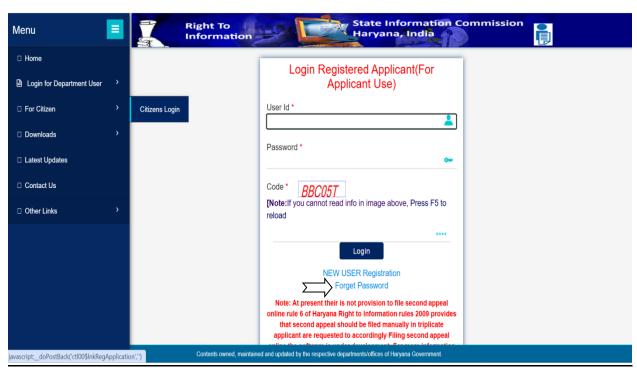


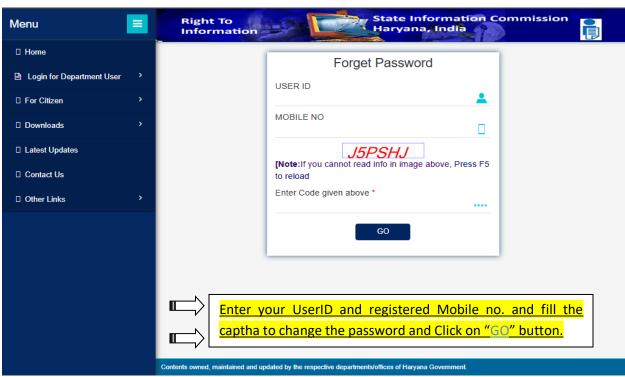
Note: Add your identity proof with your address details as without your address details you are not verified and your RTI information will not be furnished.

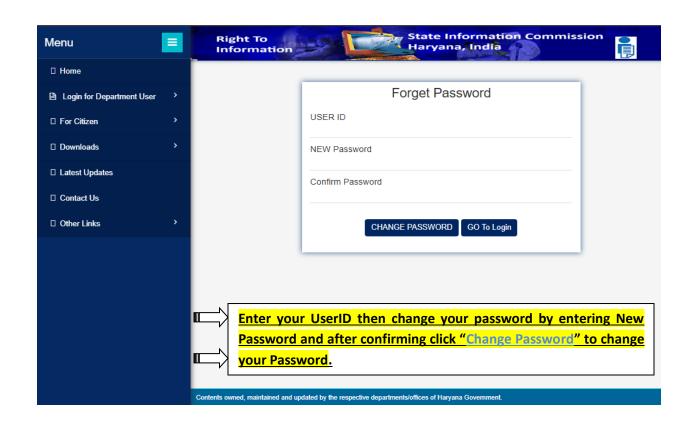
Once you register yourself. Kindly login through your user credentials from <u>For citizen > "Citizens Login option" page.</u>



If You already have any userID but forget its password then click on "Forget Password" option to change the password.

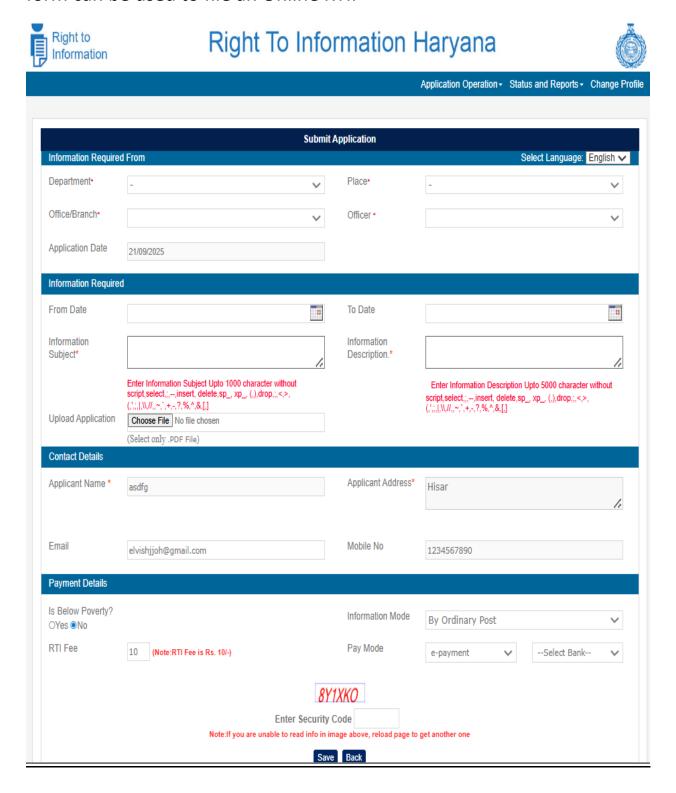






After Login:-

This is the main dashboard for citizens to Submit Application. This form can be used to file an Online RTI.



Submitting Application

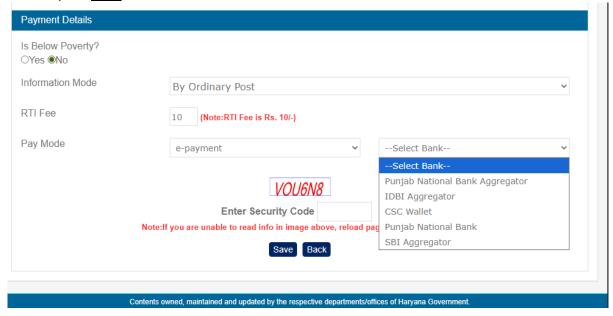
- 1. This web portal can be used to file RTI Application online and also to make payment for RTI application Online. First Appeal is also filled online.
- 2. An applicant who desires to obtain any information under RTI Act can make a request through this web portal to the Departments of government of Haryana.
- 3. The fields marked * are mandatory while others are optional.
- 4. The on clicking at "Submit Application", the applicant has to fill the required details on the page that will appear.
- 5. Enter the details as per the prescribed columns.
- 6. Select Department Name from the dropdown list for which the Applicant wants to file an RTI.
- 7. Officer list will be shown only after choosing same Place(District) and Office/Branch field.
- 8. At present, the text in the Information Subject field will be upto 1000 characters.
- 9. If your desired information description having more than 5000 characters then upload the attachment in Upload Application field.
- 10. <u>In Payment Details column, you have two options:</u>
 - i. If an applicant belongs to BPL category he will select the option Yes in "Is Below Poverty?" field and he has to upload BPL card certificate in supporting Document field.



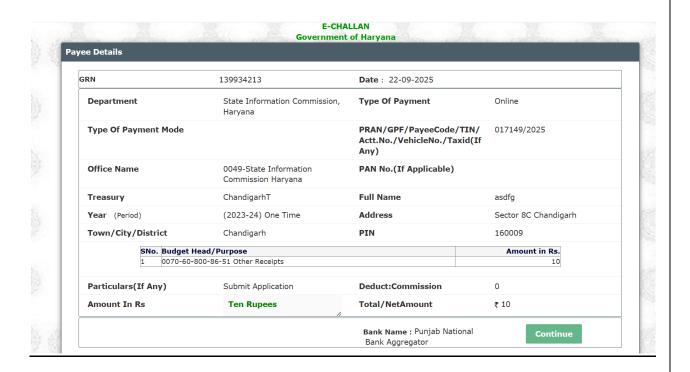
No fees is required to be paid by any citizen who is below poverty line as per the RTI Act 2012.

In case of BPL category the applicant can click on <u>Save button</u> to submit the RTI application. On submission of the application, a unique registration number would be issued, which may be referred by the applicant for any references in future.

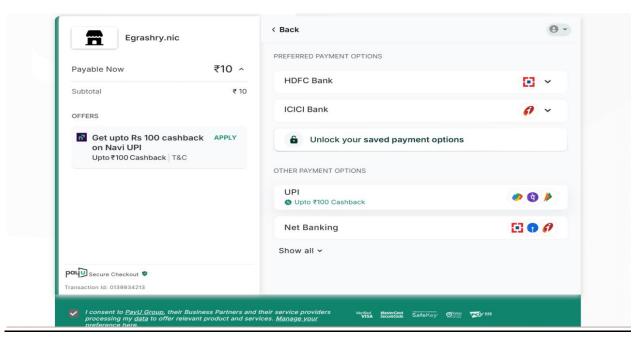
- ii. If an applicant is non BPL then he/she has to make a payment of 10rs fees as per the RTI Act.
- 11. The applicant can pay the prescribed fees through the following modes after selecting any of the Aggregator:
 - i) Internet banking
 - ii) Using credit/debit card of Master/Visa
 - iii) UPI



- 12. Once applicant enters on Save button, Applicant will receive an sms alerts of the Application Number in case if he/she provides the mobile number at registration.
- 13. Applicant will reached to <u>E-Challan</u> Payment option, click on <u>Continue</u> option.



14. You'll see all the payment modes:



After completing the payment process, applicant will be redirected back to RTI Online Portal.

The application filed through this Web Portal would reach electronically to the concerned Department's SPIO as selected by the applicant at the time filing Application.

- 2. Supporting document should be in PDF format upto 10MB.
- 3. Text for "Information Subject" should be upto 1000 characters.
- 4. Text for "Information Description" should be upto 5000 characters.

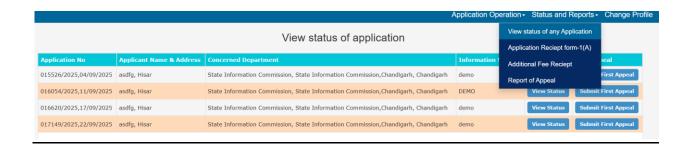
Additional fees is demanded by the concerned SPIO, if required to furnish the information you sought for.

Click on Submit fee option and fill up the bank details for the payment and proceed further.





In this option you will find the following operations like:-



a) View Status of any Application-

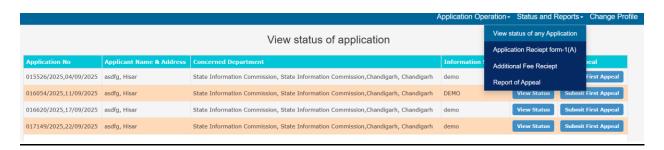
- a) i) Where applicant are able to view the Status of their Application (whether it is Disposed Off, Transferred, Rejected or Pending) by clicking on "View Status".
- a) ii) Citizen can also able to file First Appeal from here by clicking "Submit First Appeal".

Note:- (First Appeal can be filled only after 30days of RTI Application.)

- **b)** Application Receipt form-1(A)- where applicant can download receipt of their RTI application.
- c) Additional fee receipt where applicant can download receipt of the additional fees payment.
- d) Report of Appeal- where applicant can download receipt of First Appeal.

Submitting First Appeal

 For making an appeal to the first Appellate Authority, the applicant has to click at 'Submit First Appeal" in Status & Reports > View Status of any Application and fill up the form that will appear.



- 2. The registration number of original application has to be used for reference.
- 3. As per the RTI act, No fees has to be paid for first appeal.
- 4. First Appellate Authority Name will be selected through the given dropdown list.
- 5. The applicant can select reason for filing appeal application from **Reason/Grounds for Appeal** field.
- 6. Following documents can be attached at the time of filing First Appeal:
 - a) Photocopies of original RTI application with its enclosures
 - b) Acknowledgement of PIO/SPIO
 - c) Postal proof of mailing
 - d) Decision letter of PIO/SPIO

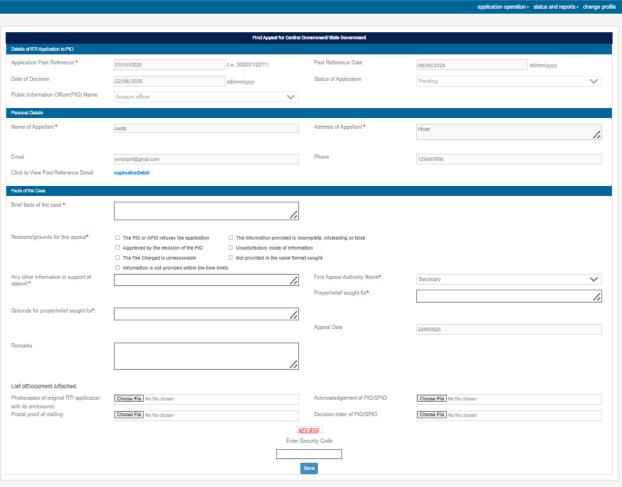

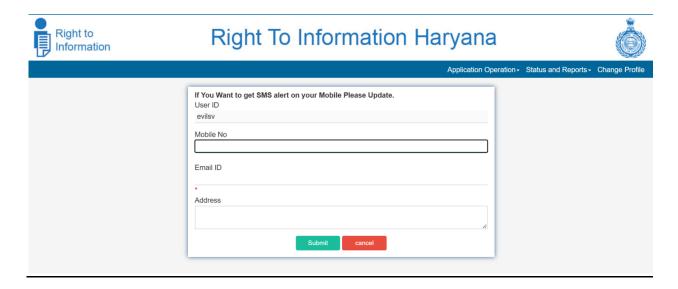
